## 1) How many miles of road have been switched to 20 mph speed limits in the each of the years 2018, 2019 & 2020?

Measurements are approximate In 2018, 5630 metres, 5.3 miles In 2019, 540 metres, 0.34 miles In 2020, None

## 2) How many miles overall are signed-only 20 mph speed limits?

43171 metres, 28.82 miles

## 3) How much money has been spent on 20 mph speed limits in the each of the years 2018, 2019, & 2020?

We estimate this to have been 2018 £22.4k 2019 £2k 2020 £0

By their nature these schemes usually are introduced as part of a wider scheme, such as traffic calming including physical measures or as an on road part of a network of cycle routes, and therefore the costs are not determinable without undertaking individual scrutiny of each scheme design and costs which we are unable to do within the cost limit for provision of information under the FOI Act, as we anticipate that it would take one officer in excess of 18 hrs work to extract this information. We therefore apply an exemption under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act.
