

NCC-049066-20 Buses in Bingham - funding costs

Further to your request for information under The Freedom of Information Act, please see below.

- Service 833, Vectare, full-service support, annual cost £268,400, revenue to the Council, contract end date 27/5/21
- Service 91, Marshalls, full-service support, annual cost £119,276 (cost includes a separate dedicated school bus service), revenue to the operator, contract end date 31/7/21
- Service 856/857, Marshalls, full-service support, annual cost £30,307, revenue to the operator, contract end date 31/7/21

There are no plans currently available for any service revisions, the Council will be reviewing all local bus support as a Covid response, S.106 funding will be part of any new proposals in the future. We trust this now resolves your enquiry. Where we have not been able to provide details, we expect that this information is not held by Nottinghamshire county Council at this time.

We suggest all requesters search under our publication scheme in advance of requesting information under the freedom of information act.
