I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request: "How much have the council spent on flood defences in the last 5 years around the river trent"

River flooding is looked after by the Environment Agency and as such, they lead on flood defences associated with the River Trent.

The NCC has undertaken some work in villages such as Girton which are close to the river to the value of approximately £100k in the last 5 years and Via will have delivered sandbags to communities likely to flood such as Gunthorpe and many others along the river.
