

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FERNWOOD FOOTPATH NO.1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall: - Proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Fernwood in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

<u>Fernwood Footpath No.1</u> between grid reference points SK 8264 5108, Hunters Road, and SK 8243 5127, The edge of the A1 road, a distance of 320 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 17th May 2021 until 16th November 2021 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available on public rights of way.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable construction of an approved housing estate with associated roads, service utilities and sewers, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
