I refer to your recent Freedom of Information request: The total amount of money spent on food and sustenance for council staff during the year 2020 to date, 2019 and as many years for which records are available.

As food and sustenance is not specifically provided for council staff, no records are maintained. Refreshments, for example, are only provided for meetings or events where members of the public are due to attend, so it would not be possible to attribute any of that cost as a provision for council staff, even if the record of each order was investigated.
