Dear Requester,

Further to your request for information under The Freedom of Information Act, please see below from the department.

We do not have a map layer showing prohibited routes for freight vehicles, as there are many sites and destinations in Nottinghamshire.

Anything that is an Abnormal Load must be notified to the local Highway Authority.

The Freight Vehicle Association use ESDAL and email to contact the local Highway Authorities.

All other height or weight restrictions are signed in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (TSRGD 2016)

Hauliers must comply with their duty,

Abnormal loads

An 'abnormal load' is a vehicle that has any of the following:

- a weight of more than 44,000kg
- an axle load of more than 10,000kg for a single non-driving axle and 11,500kg for a single driving axle
- a width of more than 2.9 metres
- a rigid length of more than 18.65 metres

We have a list of 'low bridges' but not in a map layer.
