### **Brief Description of Project**

To develop an additional two calssrooms for teaching. Assessment of funding required is being undertaken. No additional funding to the HNPCA has been identified for this project. Without additional capital funding, projects will need to be prioritised.

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Yeoman Park Academy has been identified by the DfE as a school for a rebuild or refurbishment. The County Council is considering contributing to the cost to add 28 additional place to the Academy's current NOR of 110. Currently any funding to the project will come from the HNPCA. Previous inspection as a maintained special school was graded as outstanding (2013).

Expansion of school (opened in September 2019). The plans for the new school included the option to expand the building and NOR by 30. No additional funding to the HNPCA has been identified for this project. Without additional capital funding, projects will need to be prioritised. Previously a maintained primary school (URN: 122611),which was closed following consultation due to low numbers of pupils. To reopen depending upon the outcome of a consultation process as a primary specialist satellite centre. Without additional capital funding, projects will need to be prioritised. Previously a maintained primary and nursey school (URN: 122617), which was closed following consultation due to a new school being built to meet demand from nearby housing developments. Feasibility to be undertaken to determine whether to reopen as a specialist satellite centre. Without additional capital funding, projects will need to be prioritised.

To provide funding to Academies to improve access to facilities so a child or young person with a disability can attend a mainstream educational setting. This funding would not be for works that settings should already have undertaken in terms of equality legislation.
