

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

In accordance with the provisions of Section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act (EIA) 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, that Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make a prescribed alteration to Derrymount Special School by:

- increasing its capacity by 20 places from January 2023.
- constructing a two-classroom modular-building, plus associated external and car park works at the Upper School site in Daybrook.
- This will mainly accommodate additional students with autistic spectrum disorder (ASD) needs.
- As Derrymount Special School is a local authority maintained school and the proposed expansion will increase its roll by more than 10%, NCC is required to manage a process of statutory consultation with respect to this proposed change.
