

Retained existing hedgerow

- 3m wide mown amenity grass strip to edge of verge to accomodate underground utilities. Full highway verge to have 5m minimum width allowing equestrians crossing the A6097 to ride back to East Bridgford Road utilising the back half of the verge behind line of street lighting columns and traffic signs .

(Taking into account recent feedback, the final treatment at this location will be developed during detailed design and in collaboration with specialist stakeholders)

> Proposed Pegasus Crossing linking existing bridleway on NE side to verge on SW side of A6097 enabling safe route for riders back to East Bridgford Road
