

CENTRAL SCHOOL SERVICES BLOCK FUNDING 2023-24

Purpose of the Report

1. To seek Early Years & Schools Forum (the Forum) approval to centrally retain funding within the Central School Services Block of the 2023-24 Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG).

Information and Advice

2. The Central School Services Block continues to provide funding for local authorities to carry out central functions on behalf of maintained schools and academies. This includes ongoing responsibilities and historic commitments.
3. The element of funding within CSSB that local authorities receive for historic commitments made prior to 2013 to 2014 has been reduced. In 2023 to 2024 historic commitments funding has been reduced by 20%.
4. The local authority is required to seek approval from the Forum to centrally retain funding within the Central School Services Block (CSSB) of the DSG. Attached at **Appendix A** to this report is a list of the central budgets the Authority is seeking approval to retain.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Forum:

- 1) Approve the Authority's application to centrally retain funding within the Central School Services Block for the services set out at **Appendix A**.
