What are the aims of your proposed activity / policy? (Please keep to approximately 100 words.): As part of the Council's aim to continually improve service delivery and embed the principles of the Adult Social Care Strategy, there is a need to review the provision of registered residential care to ensure that the care and support provided is strengths based, maintains, or increases people's independence, reflects best practice and that people are supported in an environment that best meets their needs.

There are currently six people with learning disabilities living at Church Street and two long standing vacancies. Many of the residents have declining health and mobility and increasing needs and combined with the limitations of the building environment to meet those needs in the future, there is a need to individually review their care and support needs to identify the optimal setting to meet their needs now and in the future as their level of need increases, whilst exploring opportunities to increase their independence, where possible. This may result in people being supported to alternative placements that better suits their needs.
