(ELSTON FOOTPATH NO. 14 AND EAST STOKE FOOTPATH NO. 7)  
DIVERSION ORDER (2024)

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths and the public it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

The Newark and Sherwood District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.


BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situate at Elston and East Stoke and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation and certification of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation and certification of this Order be footpaths over the land situate at Elston and East Stoke described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

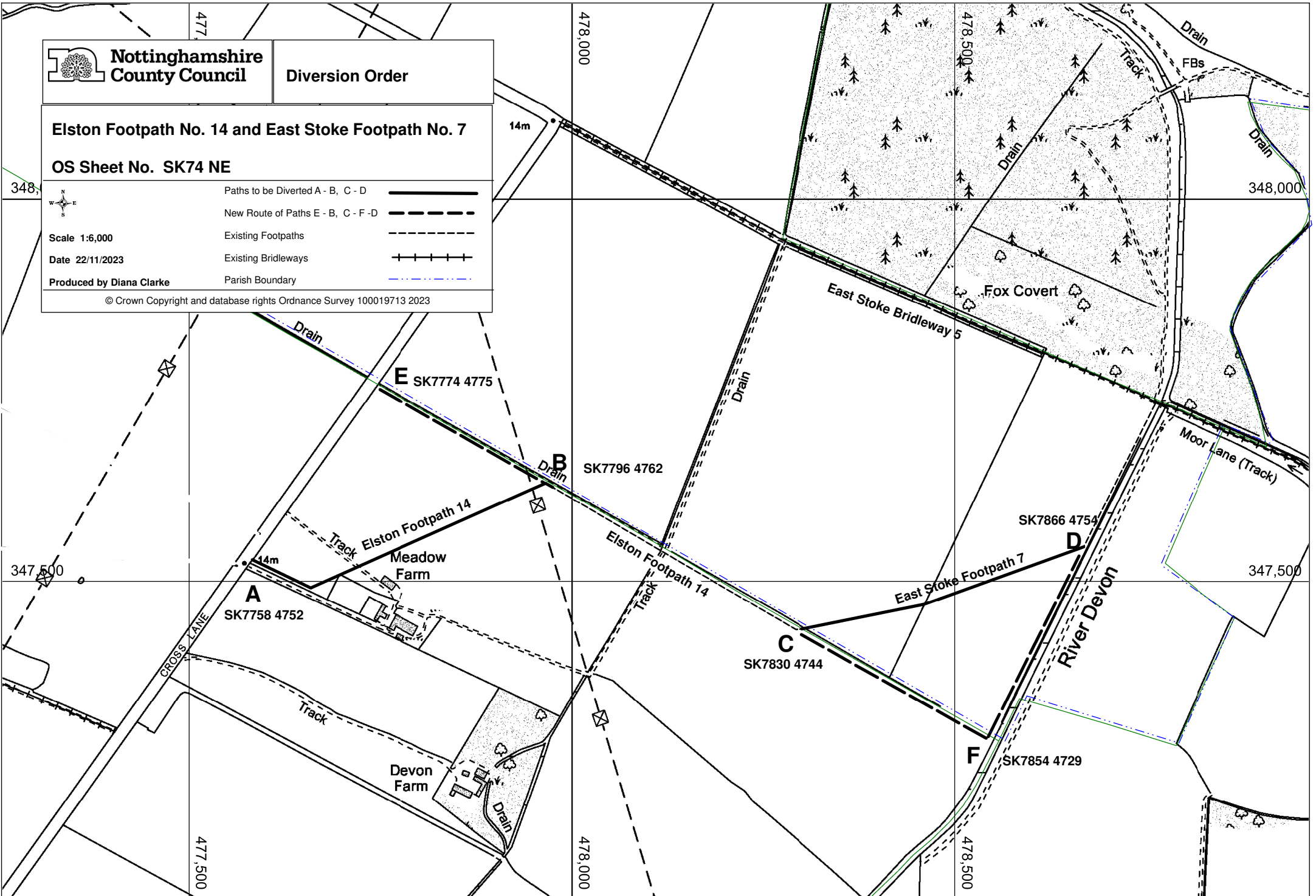

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Paths or Ways

Elston Footpath No. 14

The whole width of that part of Public Footpath No. 14 commencing at point A, (SK7758 4752), at the junction with Cross Lane and proceeding for a distance of approximately 440 metres in a south-easterly then east-north-easterly direction to point B (SK 7796 4762).

East Stoke Footpath No. 7

The whole width of that part of Public Footpath No. 7 commencing at point C, (SK7830 4744), at the junction with Elston Footpath No. 14 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 380 metres in an east-north-easterly direction to point D (SK 7866 4754).

PART 2

Description of Site of New Paths or Ways

Elston Footpath No. 14

Commencing at point E, (SK7774 4775), at the junction with Cross Lane and proceeding for a distance of approximately 250 metres in a south-easterly direction to join the remainder of Footpath No. 14 at point B (SK7796 4762), having a width of 1.5 metres along the field edge. Then commencing at point C (SK7830 4744), on the remainder of Elston Footpath No. 14 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 560 metres in a south-easterly direction to the junction with the River Devon at point F (SK7854 4729), having a width of 1.5 metres along the field edge on a grass and earth surface.

East Stoke Footpath No. 7

Commencing at the junction with Elston Footpath No. 14, at point F (SK7854 4729) and proceeding in a north-north-easterly direction to Point D (SK7866 4754) to meet remainder of Footpath No. 7, having a width of 1.5 metres along the field edge on a grass and earth surface.
