Self service is already a success at our Mapperley and Kimberley libraries, where it's been welcomed by both staff and customers. We're now bringing the benefits to your local library too.

As well as introducing self service, we're also taking this opportunity to improve how books are displayed and make general improvements to the layout of your library.

It's good news because:

- self service is quick and easy to use, saving you time - it's simpler than the machines you see in supermarkets
- staff will be able to spend less time issuing books, and more valuable time with you
- as self service units are small and modern, there's no need for huge counters – leaving more space for the books and you
- your library's book collection will also be improved
- we'll make it easier for you to find the books you want, by improving the display and presentation

We'll have to close for a short time – but we'll be back soon

To make these improvements, your library will need to be closed from **Monday 25 January** and will re-open on **Monday 15 February**. But don't worry, in the run-up to the closure, loan periods and entitlements have been increased, so you can stock up on enough of the books you love till we re-open.
