How to get to Riverside Way

On foot

Riverside Way Offices are situated south east of Nottingham City Centre close to the Wilford Bridge end of the Nottingham Trent Embankment. It is easily walked from Nottingham Railway Station (10 minutes) or Nottingham City Centre (15/20 minutes) via public footpath - see directions below under Public Transport.

Cycling

There are good cycle paths leading to Riverside Way Offices from most directions. E-mail: steps@nottsc.gov.uk for a cycle map. There is the facility to store your cycle securely undercover.

Public transport

Nottingham Midland Railway Station is a 10 minute walk away. Leave the station via the front entrance onto Carrington Street, cross over Carrington Street, turn left then immediately right into Sheriffs Way and follow the off road cycle/footpath past the Castle Rock Brewery. This heads down into the Meadows. Queens Walk is a flat off road path that cuts straight through to the toll bridge roundabout (Wilford toll bridge) Riverside Offices are a few hundred metres on the right from here.

Nottingham's Broadmarsh Bus Station is close to the Midland Railway Station and is 10-15 minutes walk from Riverside Way.

By Car

Riverside Way Offices are on Riverside Way off the A453 Queens Drive south of Nottingham City Centre. Directions can be found on the AA web site - www.theaa.com/travelwatch/planner_main.jsp.

The car park is for staff and visitors there are two disabled parking bays close to the entrance door. Cycles can be stored securely under cover.
