Administration day

This pattern gives 194 working days for staff, including the administration day on Monday 6 September 2010. A total of 4 in-service training days for staff will be taken by each school from the 193 term days given above, leaving 189 term days for pupils. The standard school year has been reduced by one day, to incorporate the additional public holiday marking the royal wedding. We recommend that schools close for the additional day on Tuesday 3rd May 2011, although schools may wish to select an alternative date during 2010-11.
