

## Sutton Bus Station Improvement Scheme

Following a review of Sutton bus station facilities an improvement plan was drawn up to address concerns about pedestrian safety and congestion and to improve the urban environment.

The improvement scheme provides:

- A revised bus station layout making it easier for buses to operate.
- New high quality bus shelters with the facility to add real time information displays at a later date.
- Raised kerbs to assist passengers getting on and off buses particularly those using wheelchairs or parents with push chairs.
- CCTV and improved lighting to increase passenger safety and security.
- Improved crossing facilities to help pedestrians cross the road safely.
- New safety railings to protect pedestrians around the bus station facilities.
- An electronic journey planning kiosk and improved public transport information.
- An improved environment with new paving and landscaping.

We would like to thank you for being patient during the temporary closure and hope that you will find the new bus station facilities make your journey a more pleasant experience.

**From Monday 27th April 2009** buses will return to the new Sutton in Ashfield bus station following a major improvement scheme. This leaflet provides details of the bus services to and from Sutton tells you which bay to use for your journey.





# New bus departure bays



While the new bus station design is similar to the old layout there are some minor changes to departure bays. All services to Stanton Hill and Skegby will leave from Bay E while F & G will be for direct Mansfield services. All services leaving in a westerly direction will leave from Bays A, B, C and D.
