WESTMINSTER BRIEFING – A NEW PLAN FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE – HEALTHY, SAFE AND HAPPY 4TH DECEMBER 2007 IN LONDON

1 Purpose of the Report

To seek approval for

- a) attendance of one Member at the Westminster Briefing A New Plan for Children and Young People – Healthy, Safe and Happy on 4th December 2007 in London
- b) the travel and accommodation necessary in connection with the event.

2 Information and Advice

- 2.1 Under the Travel and Accommodation Policy and other arrangements approved by the full Council on 7th October 2004, this Committee is the appropriate body for considering/approving attendance at a range of events and the travel and accommodation requirements arising there from:
- 2.2 This report describes a proposal which is within the Committee's decision making powers and Members are asked to consider whether attendance at the event should be approved, together with any necessary travel, accommodation or other arrangements.
- 2.3 The information included within the following section of the report should ensure compliance with normal decision making rules. If attendance is approved, the details referred to below will be used to compile the Public Register, which is available on the Council's website.

- The New 10 Year Youth Strategy: Developing a More Coordinated Approach
