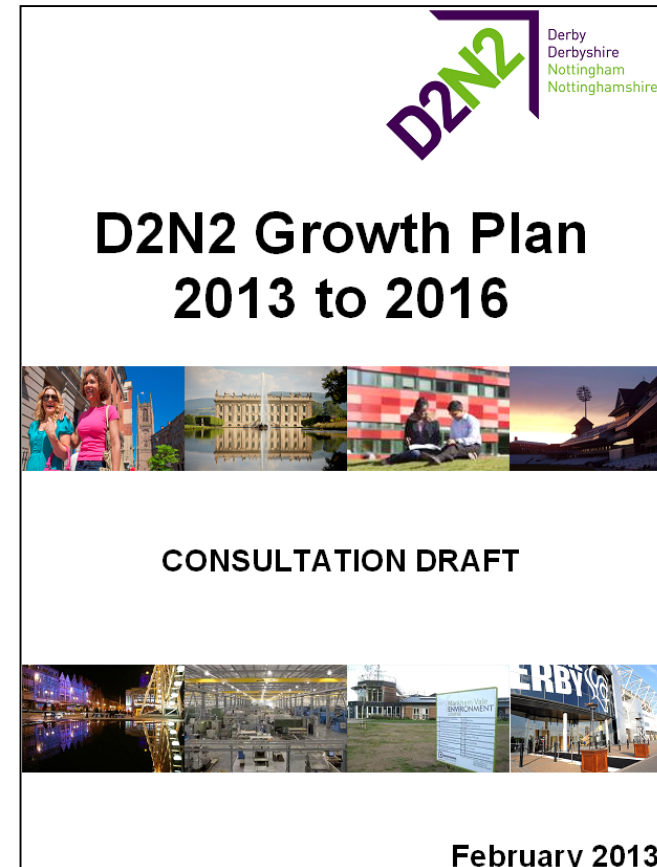

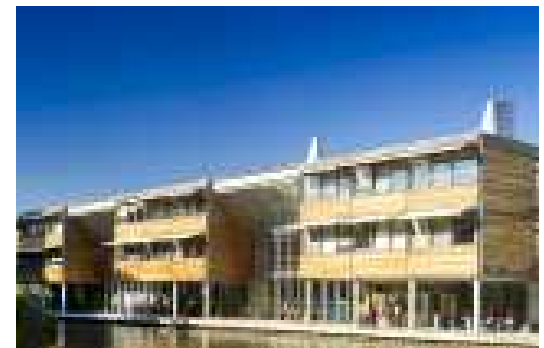
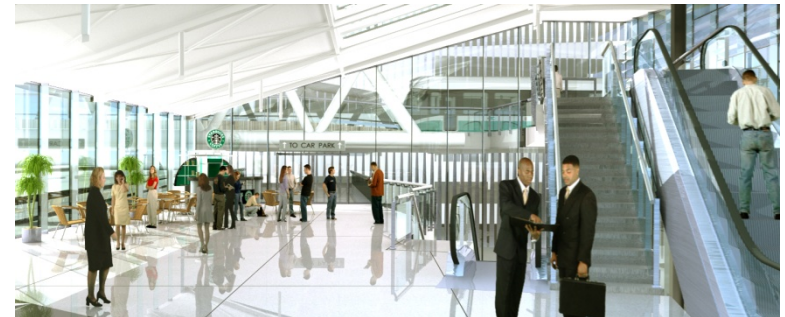

- PWLB facility of up to £60 million
- Single Pot from 2015 onwards
