REPORT OF THE HEAD OF MEMBERS' SERVICES

Cabinet/Corporate Management Board (CMB) - Awaydays

Purpose

To secure approval for further awaydays for the Cabinet and Chief Officers (CMB) for the new administration.

The Cabinet and Chief Officers have been meeting regularly throughout the administration, to discuss key issues affecting the County Council. An initial report on this was considered by the Administration Committee on the 7th June 2005.
