REPORT OF THE MONITORING OFFICER

STANDARDS BOARD ANNUAL ASSEMBLY 2009

1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 To seek approval to arrange for attendance at the Standards Board for England's Annual Assembly of Standards Committees, in Birmingham on 12-13 October 2009.

2. <u>Information and Advice</u>

2.1 Each year the Standards Board organises an assembly for Standards Committee members and monitoring officers from across England. The assembly provides an opportunity to look in depth at standards in action, share examples of good practice examples and discuss the practicalities of the local assessment of complaints.

The Assembly will address key strategic issues for ethical governance and answers questions on key areas of the standards framework. It will provide participants with the learning and practical resources they need to improve and promote standards and local democracy in their authority.

2.2 It is proposed that the Chair and two Vice-Chairs of the Standards Committee attend the Assembly. The costs of members' attendance are estimated as:
