

# Forward Plan

**Published 26 April 2022**

This Forward Plan supersedes all previous Forward Plans.

## What is the Forward Plan?

The Forward Plan contains details of Key Decisions to be taken by The Cabinet, Cabinet Members and Chief Officers. It does not include decisions to be taken by Full Council or any of the Council's other non-executive committees such as Planning and Licensing Committee or Governance and Ethics Committee.

## What is a Key Decision?

A Key Decision is one made in the exercise of a Cabinet function which is likely:

- a. to result in the County Council incurring expenditure which is, or the making of savings which are, significant, having regard to the County Council's budget for the service or function to which the decision relates;

For this purpose, "significant" shall mean an expenditure or saving of £1million or more for both revenue and capital expenditure.

**or**

- b. to be significant in terms of its effect on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more electoral divisions in the area of the County Council

## How much notice is given of forthcoming decisions?

As far as possible and in the interests of transparency, the Council will seek to provide at least 28 clear days' notice of new Key Decisions that are listed in this document.

Where this is not practicable, such Key Decisions will be taken under urgency procedures as set out in the Constitution.

## **Notice of Intention to Conduct Business of the Cabinet in Private**

Whilst the majority of the business at Cabinet meetings will be open to the public to attend, there will inevitably be some business to be considered that contains, for example, confidential, commercially sensitive or personal information as set out in Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended).

The Forward Plan entries indicate any elements of Key Decision reports which are expected to be considered by Cabinet in private along with the relevant grounds for exemption and reasons why that exemption needs to be applied (the 'Public Interest Test').

The Appendix at the end of this document contains a list of any **non-Key Decision** reports which are also due to be considered by Cabinet in private and indicates whether those reports are expected to be fully or partly exempt, along with the relevant grounds for exemption and reasons why that exemption needs to be applied (the 'Public Interest Test').

If you feel that any decisions or reports that are to be discussed in private should be considered in public, please contact Democratic Services (County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham, NG2 7QP, [democratic.services@nottsc.gov.uk](mailto:democratic.services@nottsc.gov.uk) with your reasons. Such representations must be received no later than **14 days** before the Cabinet meeting, the item is due to be considered. This Council is required to consider any representations received as to why an item should not be taken in private and to publish its decision in advance of the decision being taken.

What is the decision to be taken	To seek approval to invest forecasted uncommitted Public Health Grant funding over the next four years to improve health and wellbeing outcomes for people in Nottinghamshire County.
Who will be consulted?	The strategy and focus of the investment proposals are based on the priorities of the Nottinghamshire Plan and Joint Health & Wellbeing Strategy (JHWS). Both of these key documents have involved extensive engagement with partners, stakeholders and residents. In the case of the JHWS, a number of roadshows took place across the county during November and December 2021 which enabled residents to share which aspects of health and wellbeing is most important to them. Detailed investment proposals were drawn up with input from colleagues across the council and prioritised based on an assessment of their Public Health impact, equity, affordability, and value for money. More detailed engagement will take place with lead members for Public Health before being presented to cabinet.
