(a) Motion 1

"The proposed closure of the Sutton, Stapleford and Gedling recycling centres is causing a great deal of concern for local residents. The closures are likely to result in reduced recycling rates, increased levels of fly-tipping, and could damage relationships with District partners. There are further worries over increased site traffic, travelling distance and additional car miles if residents take their waste to alternative centres in Beeston. Hucknall, Kirkby and Calverton.

#### This Council:

- 1. Notes that the Stapleford, Sutton and Gedling facilities have excellent, and rising, recycling rates (84%, 70% and 60% respectively, for 2008/9)
- 2. Acknowledges the additional pressures these closures would place on District Councils
- 3. Given the level of public outcry the Council agrees to remove these closures from its budget plans, keeping the centres open."
