This Forward Plan supersedes all previous Forward Plans.

What is the Forward Plan?

The Forward Plan contains details of Key Decisions to be taken by The Cabinet, Cabinet Members, Chief Officers and any Committees of Cabinet including the City of Nottingham and Nottinghamshire Economic Prosperity Committee. It does not include decisions to be taken by Full Council or any of the Council's other non-executive committees.

What is a Key Decision?

A Key Decision is one made in the exercise of a Cabinet function which is likely:

- a. to result in the County Council incurring expenditure which is, or the making of savings which are, significant, having regard to the County Council's budget for the service or function to which the decision relates;

For this purpose, "significant" shall mean an expenditure or saving of £1million or more for both revenue and capital expenditure.

or

- b. to be significant in terms of its effect on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more electoral divisions in the area of the County Council

How much notice is given of forthcoming decisions?

As far as possible and in the interests of transparency, the Council will seek to provide at least 28 clear days' notice of new Key Decisions that are listed in this document. Where this is not practicable, such Key Decisions will be taken under urgency procedures as set out in the Constitution.

Notice of Intention to Conduct Business of the Cabinet in Private

Whilst the majority of the business at Cabinet meetings will be open to the public to attend, there will inevitably be some business to be considered that contains, for example, confidential, commercially sensitive or personal information as set out in Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended).

The Forward Plan entries indicate any elements of Key Decision reports which are expected to be considered by Cabinet in private along with the relevant grounds for exemption and reasons why that exemption needs to be applied (the 'Public Interest Test').

The Appendix at the end of this document contains a list of any **non-Key Decision** reports which are also due to be considered by Cabinet in private and indicates whether those reports are expected to be fully or partly exempt, along with the relevant grounds for exemption and reasons why that exemption needs to be applied (the 'Public Interest Test').

If you feel that any decisions or reports that are to be discussed in private should be considered in public, please contact Democratic Services (County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham, NG2 7QP, democratic.services@nottscc.gov.uk with your reasons. Such representations must be received no later than **14 days** before the Cabinet meeting, the item is due to be considered. This Council is required to consider any representations received as to why an item should not be taken in private and to publish its decision in advance of the decision being taken.

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| Decision | Recommissioning of provider frameworks for independent specialist education placements |

| What is the decision to be taken | <p data-bbox="699 454 1241 488">Brief summary of decision to be taken</p> <p data-bbox="699 521 1377 846">The County Council has a statutory responsibility to secure school places for all children, including those whose special educational needs are assessed as being unable to be met within a mainstream school and for whom the Council is thus obliged to procure a specialist education placement within the independent / non-maintained school sector.</p> <p data-bbox="699 891 1385 1328">Since 2015, the Council has procured these placements via 2 separate frameworks – one for Independent Schools and one for Alternative Providers. These two frameworks are due to cease in 2023 and need to be replaced by new frameworks in order that the Council can continue to meet its statutory obligation to provide school places in a way that is compliant with the Council’s Financial Regulations. Approval is thus sought to go out to tender and to award the contract in line with the outcome of that exercise.</p> |
| Who will be consulted? | <p data-bbox="699 1402 1361 1615">These education placements are funded from the High Needs Block portion of the Nottinghamshire Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG). The Schools Forum thus has financial oversight of the resultant annual spend on these specialist placements.</p> <p data-bbox="699 1659 1377 2022">Discussions have also taken place with neighbouring local authorities, in particular those within the D2N2 footprint with whom we jointly commission several specialist services for children and young people. In this instance, it has been agreed, as each authority recommissions its own local provider framework, that each will allow access to all for D2N2 authorities so that each Council can place children across D2N2 with ‘approved</p> |

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| | <p>providers' under common contractual terms and conditions.</p> <p>Providers on the existing frameworks are also aware of the recommissioning exercise; in particular the Council's wish to explore different forms of contracting, including block contracts, to ensure local capacity can be maintained at a level commensurate with the increasing demand for independent specialist placements.</p> |
