## **Hospitality for Education Department Performances**

## **Purpose of Report**

 The purpose of this report is to request approval for the provision of hospitality for elected members and guests at concert performances to be given by Nottinghamshire Education Symphony Orchestra and Concert Band.

#### Information and Advice

Refreshments for all civic guests will be provided during the interval.
