REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF RESOURCES

PENSION FUND TRAINING AND SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING

1. Purpose

- 1.1 To seek approval for
 - (a) Attendance at a Pension Fund Training event and an Investment Sub-Committee meeting on 28/29 July 2005.
 - (b) The travel and accommodation necessary in connection with the event.

2. Information and Advice

- 2.1 A survey amongst members of the Pensions Investment Sub Committee last year showed that members find benefit in having some of their meetings at the offices of fund managers, provided that some training can be provided, as well as the meeting.
- 2.2 The next meeting of the Investment Sub Committee is scheduled for 29 July 2005, and very recently, Schroders have offered to host this meeting at their offices in London, and provide training sessions on the preceding afternoon. Training on current topical matters is important for members of the Investment Sub Committee, acting in their role as quasi-pension fund trustees, and particularly with there being several new members of the Sub-Committee.

3. <u>Financial Implications</u>

- 3.1 The County Council's representatives will require rail travel and hotel accommodation for one night.
- 3.2 The costs are estimated at:
