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Overview of Trust Services Linked to the Wellbeing and Social Inclusion Service

- Service Developments to link to reconfiguration of Community Mental Health Services
- Interconnected Care Pathways, single point of access and self assessment
- Promoting prevention, anti-stigma strategies and community integration
- Transitions function – Service User needs and preferences mapped
- Increased choice and range of available services
- Self Directed care and support – personalised services


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Service Change, Domains, Pathways and Use of Resources

- Service change linked to Estates review
- Review of Broad Street building base to be undertaken
- Broad Street to support wellbeing, arts, culture and sports domain
- Foster Drive to support all vocational and occupational therapy services
- Single point of access and self assessment to underpin Care Pathway
- Detailed service action plans to be developed alongside Service User Reference Groups
- Communication strategy to advise all stakeholders

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Involvement Framework

- Reference groups and forums to be established across all domains for Service Users and Carers
- Representation from Service Users and Carers on Steering Group
- Paid Service User and Carer Consultants to link with Steering Groups and Reference Groups
- Recruitment of Consultants to be led by Service users and Carers
- Key statutory partners as members of Steering Group
- Direct Payments uptake to be key priority
- Close working between Steering Group and all Commissioners
- Mapping all key external partners
- Developing new partnership working
- Identifying Service User led models of delivery

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
