PRIMARY CARE LIAISON
Single Point of Entry: Monday-Friday 9am-5pm.

- Advice and support to primary care
- Entry in to secondary services.
- Triage Function; assessment and Sign Posting.
- Treatment and care for those with time limited disorders who can benefit from specialist intervention.

Early Intervention Service.

- Clients age 16-35 first presentation of psychotic symptoms and their families.
- Assessment and screening
- Up to three years of intervention

Assertive Outreach

- Clients who have a serious mental illness, primarily psychosis with a high level of disability
- Poor engagement with services and treatment
- High use of inpatient, intensive home care packages
- Multiple and complex needs.

Rehabilitation & Recovery

- On-going treatment & monitoring of those with severe & persistent mental disorder.
- Longer term disorders of lesser severity but requiring pro-active follow-up.
- Significant ongoing risk &/or self-harm to self or others.
- Some severe disorders of personality may be included.
