### **Hospitality for Children and Young People's Services Arts Support Service performances**

#### **Purpose of report**

1. The purpose of this report is to request approval for the provision of hospitality for elected members and guests at the annual Christmas Concert to be given by Nottinghamshire Children and Young People's Department's Arts Support Service.
