List of evidence and summary of evidence:

Documentary – Finance Act map of relevant part of Carlton showing all of claimed route as public highway. Existence of residences suggests route up to Ethel Avenue / Emmanuel Avenue junction (& also Emmanuel Avenue itself) is unregistered carriage road i.e. Byway, but Byway rights extinguished via NERC/route doesn't fit Byway definition of WCA 1981 Section 66 therefore Restricted Byway is appropriate status.

Land Registry document refers to 1945 conveyance of part of Kendrick Road section to Gedling BC (originally Carlton UDC) and suggests public use / public repair.

User evidence – 23 evidence forms, showing use on foot / cycle going back to 1970. Unsubstantiated claims that access has not always been available, but this is not significant in light of documentary evidence.

Documentary / user combination indicates bridleway is appropriate status for Ethel – Kendrick.
