Outcome of the Panel's consideration of the Nottinghamshire Police and Crime Plan 2025-29

Thank you for giving the Police and Crime Panel the opportunity to consider a final draft version before its publication of your Nottinghamshire Police and Crime Plan 2025-29 at our meeting on Monday 3 February 2025.

You'll be aware that the Panel had previously commented in detail on an earlier version of the Plan at its meeting on 16 September 2024, and we are pleased that the comments and amendments arising from that meeting have been taken on board in the current version of the Plan.

During discussion, you provided assurance that the 12 key performance indicators were sufficiently robust and ambitious, particularly around the 2% point increase in positive outcomes for Violence Against Women and Girls and the 2% point increase in positive outcomes for crime. It was explained that it was challenging to drive positive changes in perception, and that a raft of detailed information sat below these headline performance indicators.

Arising from this part of the discussion, it was agreed that this more detailed information would be shared with the Panel, and an offer was also made to provide a briefing session to explain the rationale for the targets included in the Plan.

The point was also made that there was scope to have a higher profile for road safety within the Plan, and that having an increased physical presence at schools during busy periods could help prevent issues arising and provide reassurance to residents.
