REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENT

BUS STATION STUDY TOUR – Notification of postponement.

Purpose of Report

1. To inform the committee that the proposed bus station study tour to Lancashire, Liverpool and the South Yorkshire areas on the 3rd and 4th of March has been postponed.

Background

2. It was intended to take a group of officers and members to view recently constructed bus stations to gain an insight into other authority's best practice, in advance of NCC's own programme to upgrade and refurbish some of its own bus stations.
3. On 16th February 2005, the Administration Committee gave approval to the tour taking place. However, since that date, the majority of the members indicated their inability to attend and alternative dates could not be agreed upon. Therefore the decision was taken to postpone the tour until after the 5th May elections.
4. The Administration Committee will be notified, should the tour be proposed again.
