## REPORT OF SERVICE DIRECTOR, HIGHWAYS

## COUNTRYSIDE ACCESS (DEFINITIVE MAP) SCHEDULE OF CASE FILES

## **Purpose of the Report**

1. To provide an update to Planning and Licencing Committee members on the progress of Definitive Map case files.

### Information and Advice

- 2. This report covers the period April 2013 November 2014. The report provides members with an update on the range of applications which are presently being processed, and identifies any developments which have taken place in connection with the cases.
- 3. Appendix 1 sets out the existing caseload in tabular form, and indicates the stage which has been reached for each individual case. Appendix 2 provides an update on Definitive Map activities since April 2013. This includes Modification Orders made and confirmed, public inquires held, the correction of legal anomalies, and proposals to create new routes and divert existing paths.
- 4. The current backlog of claims for public rights of way is 214 paths. This includes 38 new individual path claims received since April 2014. However, path claims are usually grouped into one legal order or case therefore the backlog of 214 paths equates to 72 individual outstanding cases.
