REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF CULTURE AND COMMUNITY

Study visit by the European Funds Bureau, Poznan City Council

Purpose of the report

To seek approval of the Administration Committee for hospitality associated with a visit by the Director and officers from the European Funds Bureau of Poznan City to Nottinghamshire.

Background

The County Council and Poznan City Council have a longstanding twinning relationship, dating back to 1994, and recently formally renewed in April 2001. A number of study visits and projects are ongoing at any one time under the co-operation agreement.

The Director of the European Funds Bureau and two officers have been invited to Nottinghamshire from 8th to 13th May 2004 on a study visit to meet with the County Council's Funding Team and other Nottinghamshire partners. The Bureau has responsibility for infrastructure projects and social and cultural projects and will benefit from meeting Nottinghamshire specialists to determine how progress can be made to secure European Union funding. There will also be discussions about future joint project work and associated applications for European Union funding, including the DAPHNE programme.

The Chairman of the County Council has expressed a wish to welcome the visitors at a reception on 11th May.

Invitations have been extended to those elected members and officers with an interest in partnership working and links with Poznan City.

The estimated cost will be £225, to be met from the County Hospitality budget.
