REPORT OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE

MEMBERSHIP OF THE STANDING COMMITTEES

Purpose of the Report

1. To consider the allocation of seats on the 3 Standing Committees.

Information and Advice

- 2. At the last meeting of Council on 17 December 2009, consideration was given to the allocation of seats on committees following Councillor Victor Bobo being no longer a member of the Independent Group and joining the Conservative Group.
- 3. The decision at 17 December meeting was not unanimous and did not accord with the political proportionality in relation to the 3 Standing Committees (Communities & the Environment; Education; and Health & Wellbeing). Under the regulations the allocation of seats has to be agreed unanimously if they do not accord with political balance. It is therefore necessary for Council to reconsider the allocation of seats on these 3 Committees.
- 4. The current political balance of the Council as at December 2009 is:-
