“May I thank Councillor Zadrozny for his question.

Where a developer proposes additional highway works beyond those required by the planning approval, for example resurfacing adjacent footways to enhance the appearance of the development, these can often be managed through an existing legal agreement with the County Council (s38, s278 etc). If that is not the case the County Council may require details of the developer’s contractor’s insurance and experience of working in the highway.
