UNVEILING CEREMONY OF THE SHERWOOD FORESTERS WESTERN FRONT MEMORIAL AT TYNE COT COMMONWEALTH WAR GRAVES COMMISSION CEMETERY, NR. YPRES, BELGIUM – SATURDAY 24TH OCTOBER, 2009.

Purpose of the Report

1. To request approval for the Chairman of the County Council and his Lady to represent the Authority at the above event.

Background

2. The Sherwood Foresters Western Front Memorial Committee has invited The Chairman and a guest to attend the unveiling of the Sherwood Foresters Western Front Memorial at Tyne Cot Commonwealth War Graves Commission Cemetery nr. Ypres, Belgium on Saturday 24th October, 2009. The Lord Lieutenants of Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire will unveil the memorial, hosted by the Burgomaster and Committee of Zonnebeke.

This memorial to the 11,000 men of the Regiment who fell on the Western Front in the Great War has been made possible by the generosity of the people of Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire. It will then stand as a permanent reminder of the sacrifice made by our soldiers.

Following the Ceremony a Reception at Zonnebeke School will be held and a presentation of the Oak Tree Plaque and the opening of the Sherwood Foresters exhibition in the Passchendaele Memorial Museum.

A full weekend of commemorative events is taking place, as follows:-

Friday 23rd October – 8.00 p.m. – Wreath Laying Ceremony Saturday 24th October – 11.00 a.m. Unveiling Ceremony & Museum Opening Sunday 25th October – Battlefield Tours

The Chairman would like to attend and represent the County Council together with his Lady at this event. All Civic Heads within the County have been invited to attend.

The Chairman & Lady would travel to Ypres on the Friday and return to the UK on the Saturday after the Unveiling Ceremony and Museum Opening. Coaches have been arranged to leave from Nottingham but they are all full.

The other alternative is for the Civic Heads to travel together by mini bus but the Chairman and his Lady wish to leave on the Saturday. If the Chairman and Lady were to travel in the civic car they could offer to take another Civic Head with them to share petrol/tunnel costings.
