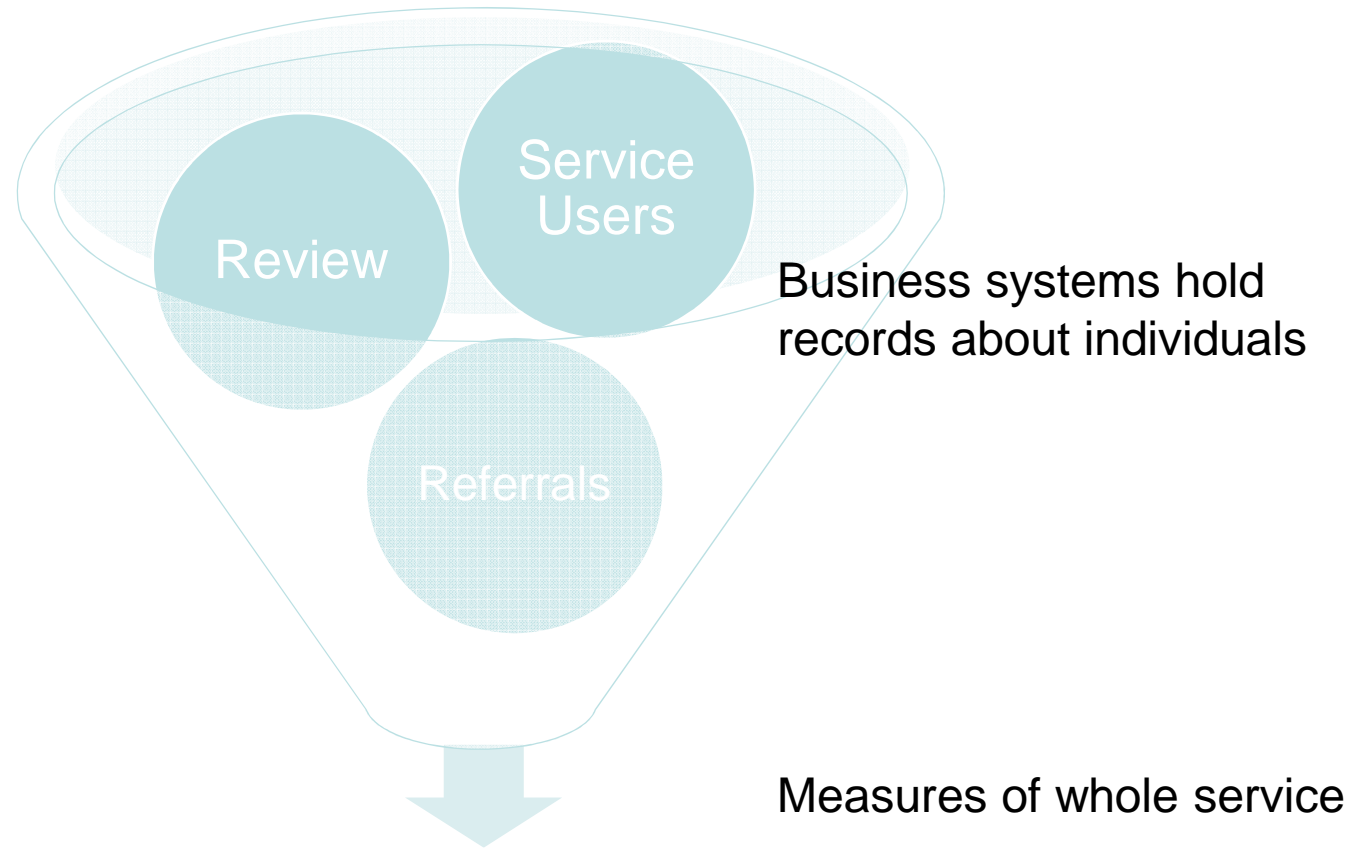
Business Intelligence

- Data mining

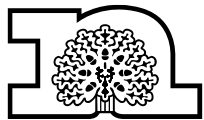
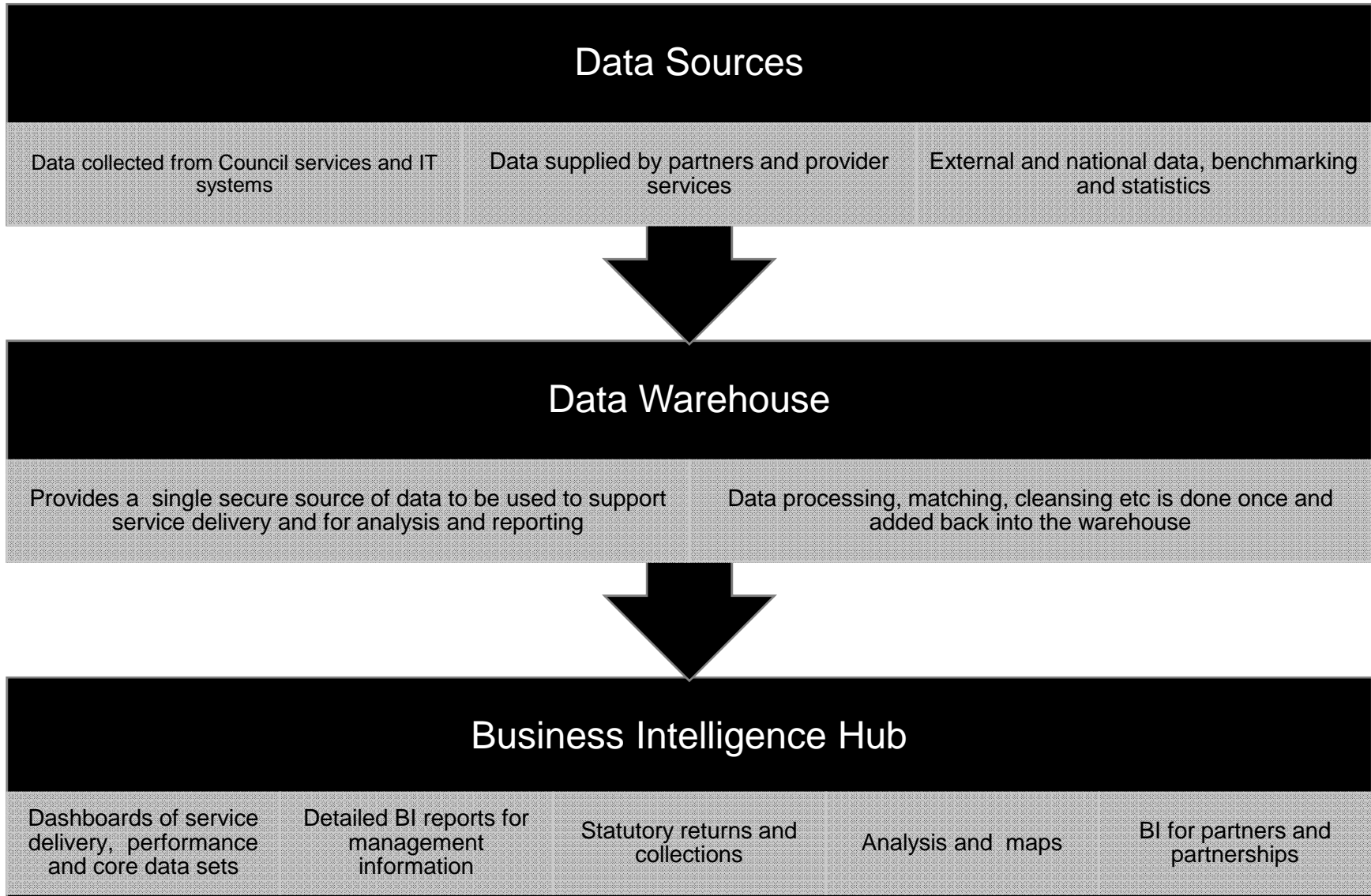
