



- 58 No STPS were completed and approved in 2005/06 financial year and these have been submitted to DfT/DfES for the allocation of capital grants to these schools. (see Appendix 1).
- In total 134 No STPs are now operational in the administrative county of Nottinghamshire as at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2006 – this represents over a third of schools in the County.
- Model Shift on the School Journey – when comparing 2005 survey results with those obtained in 2001, schools with an STP have shown a 3% reduction in car use and those without a STP a 3% increase in car use. This represents a 6% shift and was deemed to represent good progress by the Joint Steering Group.
- Walking Bus Schemes: 4No pilot “Walking Bus” schemes were in operation by February 06 and this initiative is likely to extend rapidly over the next few months.
- National Walk to School Week: 151No Primary Schools in Nottinghamshire (51%) took part in the Walk to School Week between 3 – 7 October 2005. This year’s Walk to School Week is 22 – 26 May 2006.
- Walking – Operation Whenever: This is a new initiative to encourage sustainable travel to school in Nottinghamshire. Pupils are issued with a “passport” and for every 40 sustainable journeys (20 days) they make, their passport is signed and they receive a pin badge at an awards assembly. Seven pilots are in place (one in each District) with a view to a full launch in October 2006.
- Newsletter: The fourth edition of the STP Newsletter “Pounding the Pavement” was issued to schools recently.

### **Future Actions**

4. The Joint Steering Group has agreed to meet twice yearly to monitor STP progress and future considerations will include:-
  - a) Submission of the STP Annual Report for 2005/06 to DfT/DfES and acceptance of STP completion targets. An 80% completion target has been put forward for 2010 based on the resources available and the increasing burden of keeping existing STPs refreshed and fully effective.
  - b) Implications of the latest Education legislation on School Choice which are likely to have an impact on school transport operations and also on the work of the School Travel Plan Advisors. This is due to the new duty on local authorities of knowing where pupils are going and an obligation to ease their journeys.
