NEXT STAGE REVIEW - MAJOR TRAUMA, HEART ATTACK AND STROKE SERVICES IN THE EAST MIDLANDS

1 SUMMARY

Andi Wells, Major Trauma Programme Manager, will attend today's meeting to provide pre-consultation information to the Committee on proposals being developed by NHS East Midlands for treating patients with major trauma along with heart attack and stroke patients. Major trauma is defined as an injury where the patient has less than a ten per cent chance of survival.

2 MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION

- 2.1 The Committee is asked to receive information provided at the meeting on proposals for major trauma, heart attack and stroke services, in advance of formal consultation, due to begin November 2009.

3 BACKGROUND AND SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 3.1 The purpose of today's presentation is to provide the Committee with information on the early proposals for major trauma, heart attack and stroke services in advance of the formal consultation on the arrangements.

3.2 NHS Next Stage Review

Our NHS, Our Future - The Next Stage Review was published in July 2008. Following its publication strategic health authorities and primary care trusts were required to prepare plans for the implementation of the Next Stage Review. Major trauma is one of several regional initiatives being developed by NHS East Midlands.

- 3.3 Any formal consultation on major trauma, heart attack and stroke services will involve overview and scrutiny and is likely to be carried out by a Regional Joint Health Scrutiny Committee.
