PENSION FUND INVITATION – LONDON

MONDAY 17 MAY 2004

1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 To consider the attendance of Councillor Carter at a lunchtime Seminar provided by Citigroup Asset Management on 17 May 2004.

2. <u>Information and Advice</u>

- 2.1 Councillor Carter, in his capacity as Chairman of the Pensions Committee has been invited to a lunchtime debate organised by Citigroup Asset Management on the subject of "large firms vs niche players". This event will allow Councillor Carter to participate in discussions with leading experts in the pensions management area about possible approaches that Pension Funds can adopt towards taking decisions on managing the assets of the Pension Funds.
- 2.2 There is no charge for this event, but costs will be incurred for travelling expenses at an estimated cost of £160. This will be met from the Pension Fund Trustee Training and Activities budget.
- 2.3 An Officer from the Resources Department will also be attending this Seminar.
