SPECIALIST RESIDENTIAL PROVISION AT WOODLAND VIEW - PROGRESS REPORT

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to inform the Social Services Standing Select Committee of the work of the Specialist Residential Support Study Group.
