SEVENTH ANNUAL ASSEMBLY OF STANDARDS COMMITTEES 13TH TO 14TH OCTOBER 2008

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To seek approval for
 - a) attendance at the Seventh Annual Assembly of Standards Committees
 - b) the travel and accommodation necessary in connection with the event.

2. Information and Advice

- 2.1 Under the Travel and Accommodation Policy and other arrangements approved by the full Council on 7th October 2004, this Committee is the appropriate body for considering/approving attendance at a range of events and the travel and accommodation requirements arising therefrom:
- 2.2 This report describes a proposal which is within the Committee's decision making powers and Members are asked to consider whether attendance at the event should be approved, together with any necessary travel, accommodation or other arrangements
- 2.3 The information included within the following section of the report should ensure compliance with normal decision making rules. If attendance is approved, the details referred to below will be used to compile the Public Register, which is available on the Council's website.

3. Reasons for Attendance

3.1 The Annual Assembly of Standards Committees is the leading conference on all issues concerned with the Local Government Code

- of Conduct and improving ethical standards.
- 3.2 This year's Annual Assembly will give essential information and support needed to make local assessment work in the Authority.
- 3.3 A wide range of sessions aim to meet the needs of all delegates, from new independent chairs to members of parish standards committees, to experienced monitoring officers.
- 3.4 As in previous years it is proposed that the conference be attended by the Monitoring Officer, three Members and three Independent Members.

4. Travel and Accommodation Requirements

- 4.1 If approval is granted the County Council's representatives will require accommodation and rail travel.
- 4.2 The costs associated with the event for each representative are
