3 BACKGROUND AND SUPPORTING INFORMATION

Integrated Business Plan

- 3.1 The Committee has received regular information on Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust's Integrated Business Plan since September 2007. The plan outlines how services are to be developed and delivered across the two campuses (QMC and City) and has formed an essential part of the Trust's bid for Foundation Trust status.
- 3.2 Key areas of interest to the Committee, in terms of the business plan, have been patient experience, clinical outcomes, staff satisfaction, research, teaching and training and value for money.

Foundation Trust Status

- 3.3 Representatives of NUH attended this Committee in March 2009 to formally consult with the Committee on proposals for Foundation Trust status; and in July 2009 to report the outcomes of their public consultation. NUH then decided to defer its application pending further improvements.
- 3.6 Representatives of NUH will attend today's meeting to provide an update on current progress with the application for Foundation Trust status.
