



The Nottinghamshire County Council (Clerkson's Alley, Mansfield) Gating Order 2013

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 129A to G of the Highways Act 1980 has made the above Order. The Order will have the following effect:

1. To restrict the public right of way at all times over the highway specified in the draft Order shown in the Schedule to this Notice ("the highway") by all persons except those listed in the Order.
2. To authorise the erection and maintenance of gates or other barriers on the highway in order to enforce the restriction.
3. Alternative routes for public passage are via Clumber Street, Regent Street, West Gate, Market Place, Regent Street and vice versa.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order (which was made on 1st April 2012) or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 1st April 2012, apply to the High Court.
