

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EAST MARKHAM FOOTPATH NO.34) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2015

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**East Markham Footpath No.34**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2015**.

That Notice came into force on '3rd November 2015 and was continued in force by a further Notice to '14th December 2015'

The effects are that:-

No person shall:-

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of footpath at East Markham in the Borough of Bassetlaw

East Markham Footpath No 34, from its junction with East Markham Bridleway No.2 at SK 7445 7355 to its junction with East Markham Bridleway No.1 at SK 7479 7447, a distance of 980 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 2nd May 2016 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 15th day of December 2015 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed (within a maximum period of 6 months from the date that the notice came into force).

The prohibition is required due to the need to protect public safety
