Handy Persons Adaptations Service

The Handy Persons Adaptation Service provides the help and support you may need to keep safe and secure in your home with low cost but high quality essential adaptations and small practical jobs.

The service is available to Nottinghamshire residents aged 60 or over or who have a disability. The work is carried out by professional traders who have been approved by 'Checkatrade' in partnership with our Trading Standards Service.

The traders will carry out small jobs or minor adaptations to your home to reduce the risk of a fall or help you remain living independently. Jobs range from fitting grab rails or half steps, to changing light bulbs and putting up shelves. Often, very small jobs such as fixing loose carpets can prevent a fall and avoid a lot of unnecessary distress.

There is a nominal £15 fee for some works and you can have up to four hours of handyperson work. For more information about the service or to access the

Care and Support Assessment

We suggest that initially you look at the information on pages 4 to 12. There are a number of services available to help you which are listed on: **www. nottshelpyourself.org.uk**/ We have also given details of some services you can get without assessment.

If, after exploring these options, you feel you may need more support than these can offer, then you might need to have a Care and Support Assessment. This will allow you to explain the things you are finding hard to achieve and we will discuss with you how we might be able to help you. The aim of the assessment will always be to help you regain or maintain a level of independence and we will work with you and your existing support network to try to achieve this. We will carry out the assessment in the most appropriate way depending on your needs; this could be over the telephone or at one of our clinics. If other methods are not suitable, we will arrange to complete your assessment in your own home.


We follow the Care and Support (Eligibility Criteria) Regulations 2014, issued under the Care Act 2014, when deciding who is eligible to receive community care support funded by the Council. The regulations are there to ensure that all councils make decisions about who gets help in a similar way.

If you are eligible for support, we will:

- encourage you to find solutions to your problems, if possible, by providing you with information and advice;
- consider, with you, how other people around you can help (for example, family members, friends and local organisations);
- provide help for only as long as it is needed to enable you to become, and stay, as independent as possible in your own home; and
- meet your eligible needs in the most costeffective way.

Will I have to pay towards my care?

Most people will have to make a contribution towards the cost of any care or support they receive. This is so that we can concentrate our limited resources on people with the most need and provide support to as many people as possible.

A member of staff will talk to you about your financial circumstances to decide how much you will need to pay towards your services.

If you are eligible for a personal budget, and you choose to take all or part of it as a direct payment, your benefits will not be affected and it is not counted as income for tax purposes. For more information, see below.

How would a personal budget be paid to me?

There are three ways to receive a personal budget:

1. Direct payment – this is a cash payment we give you (if you are eligible) so that you can buy the support you need yourself. A direct payment gives you the most flexibility and control over your support. You also have more responsibility for arranging your support.

2. Mixed personal budget – you can receive part of your personal budget as a direct payment and arrange some of your support yourself and ask us to arrange the rest with a managed personal budget.

3. Managed personal budget – we will arrange the services that meet your support needs for you. A managed personal budget is less flexible than a direct payment but you have less responsibility to arrange your support.

Which is the best option?

For many people, the best option is a direct payment. This allows you much more freedom to arrange the services you want, from the companies or carers you prefer, at times that suit you. Having a direct payment means that you can buy services from companies that we don't have contracts with. You can also use the money to employ a personal assistant to give you support when you want it.

To help you understand how a direct payment could work for you, we have collected some examples of how people in Nottinghamshire are using direct payments at the moment.

Case study

"Can I just say that the help our aunt is receiving from the personal assistant (PA) is of great benefit to her? The direct payment system seems to be working for us.

"My aunt now has structure to her day. The PA ensures that our aunt takes her medication and supplies her with hot meals. The PA has gained my aunt's confidence and is able to assist with some personal care, which we weren't sure she would accept initially. It takes some pressure off us, as both myself and my brothers work and have families, so it's difficult for us to be there as often as my aunt needs. However, it is comforting to know that someone we can trust is helping our aunt and is able to liaise with us and alert us to any concerns."

This is the view of a family member whose aunt has dementia and receives a personal budget via a direct payment.

Case study

Miss R is 24 years old with a physical disability and is a wheelchair user. Miss R lives with her mother in Nottinghamshire, but she wanted to attend university to complete a degree.

When living with her mother during the holidays, she doesn't require any paid support, as her mother meets all her needs.

Following her assessment, she was able to identify very clear outcomes in her support plan: to feel safe, to get up and ready for her day at university, to be comfortable during the day and night, to have a clean and tidy home and to be able to enjoy a meal.

It is essential to Miss R that she is able to have flexibility in how and when her outcomes are met. She needs to be able to call on support as required, but have time to herself and an element of freedom and independence.

Miss R has chosen to have her personal budget as a direct payment. Miss R has been very happy with the support she has been able to purchase with her direct payment. It has given her the choice and control she needs to live her life independently and enjoy her life at university. She is now in her final year.

If I were to have a direct payment, what would I need to do?

Direct payments are designed to give you more choice over your care; however, there are some things that you will need to do, such as open a separate bank account or use a pre-payment card, and keep a record of how you have spent the money (bank statements/invoices).

Would I have to manage everything by myself?

No. You are not expected to manage all of this on your own. If you need additional help, we can give you contact details of direct payment support services. You may need this support if you are employing your own staff.

Where can I get more information about direct payments?

You can contact us on: **0300 500 80 80**. If you are eligible and decide to have all or part of your personal budget as a direct payment, we can provide you with more information in the form of fact sheets.

What happens if I don't want a direct payment?

Some eligible people may not be able to have, or may not want a direct payment. If this is the case, we will arrange the care and support services you need from our approved list of providers.

It is up to you how you choose to have your personal budget. If you have a direct payment and then change your mind, you can stop it at any time.

Arranging services on your behalf

If you pay for your own care, and you want us to help arrange community-based services on your behalf, there is a £100 charge for this 'brokerage' service. It may include things like:

ringing round providers to discuss your requirements;

- taking you to visit a provider;
- negotiating rates with providers; and
- arranging taster sessions.

Staying safe and well at home

If you are assessed as being eligible for services from Nottinghamshire County Council (see page

13), there are a number of options to help you stay safe and well at home.

Telecare and Assistive Technology

Assistive Technology enables help to be requested in an emergency and may be useful to you if you feel vulnerable in your own home. Sensors around the home can automatically detect falls, fires, flooding, extreme temperatures, bed wetting and epileptic seizures, and can also tell if you have left your home at night-time, which can be useful for people with dementia.

If the sensors are triggered, an alert is either sent to a carer in your home or, alternatively, can be sent (via a special box attached to your phone line) to trained operators at a 24-hour monitoring centre. Staff at the monitoring centre will try to contact you immediately to find out more about your situation, and, if necessary, can arrange a suitable response, such as calling an ambulance or asking a friend or relative to pop round to check that you are OK.



If you have problems with your memory, other Assistive Technology can be used to prompt you to carry out daily living tasks, such as taking your medication.

If you have dementia, it is sometimes difficult for other people to know how well you are managing at home. As part of your assessment for long-term support, we may use activity sensors around the home to detect your movements (there are no cameras). Information from the activity monitors can help professionals and families to better understand how your dementia is affecting your independence and ensures that the most appropriate care is provided to help you stay in your own home.

Case study

Sinead Northey, 18 from Rainworth, has benefitted from a range of alarms and devices to help her become more independent and reduce the support that she receives from her parents, Catherine and Richard.

Sinead has an acquired brain injury, which affects her short-term memory and has given her epilepsy. She carries a sensor that detects if she has a fall and includes a button to raise the alarm if she is unwell. She also has a sensor under her mattress which informs her parents if she is having a seizure.

Her independence has increased with the use of an alarm device, which reminds her of daily tasks such as going to bed and brushing her teeth, and an automatic pill dispenser which prompts her to take her medication.

Catherine said: "The equipment we have been given has made such a difference to all of our lives.

"Sinead's short-term memory is very poor so I used to constantly remind her to do everyday tasks, which was very exhausting.

"Now she is doing these things with less support, which is great for her independence and selfesteem. She now takes a shower on her own thanks to the reminder alarm so I no longer have to keep checking on her, which affected her privacy.

"I used to have get up throughout the night to check she was OK but I have a greater peace of mind and a better night's sleep knowing the alarm will go off if she has a seizure."



Getting urgent support at home

Our 24-hour 'telecare' response service provides access to temporary home care support in emergencies, via a lifeline or the sensors mentioned on page 16. Care staff will typically be at your home within 45 minutes of being requested by your lifeline monitoring centre.

The care staff can help with a wide range of occasional emergency issues, for example:

- assistance with toileting, including helping you, or a carer to clean up following a toileting accident;
- guiding you safely back home if sensors have alerted that you have wandered at night into the immediate area outside your home;
- an emergency check-up visit if the lifeline monitoring centre cannot contact you following a call for help; and
- a reassurance visit if you are still feeling very

anxious, following an alarm call to the lifeline monitoring centre.

Once the service has been set up, you can call for help 24-hours a day by using your lifeline pendant or, if you have telecare sensors, these can automatically call for help if they detect you are at risk at home.

Assessment beds

If you have been in hospital following illness or an operation and are now medically fit to leave, you may still need some support before you can return home. Assessment beds offer you short-term support, usually in one of our care and support centres. During your stay, you will receive help with dressing, washing and any other tasks you're struggling with. We will help you adapt if you have lost any skills following your illness or operation. As your strength comes back, we will gradually reduce the level of support until you are ready to return home. If you are unable to return home, we will work with you to consider other options, such as going to live in extra care or residential care.

Intermediate care

Similar to assessment beds, intermediate care also supports you following illness or an operation. However, this short-term service is provided jointly with Health. A multi-disciplinary team, including therapy, nursing and social care staff, will work with you to help you rehabilitate.

Support at home (home care)

If you are an older person or have a physical disability, learning disability or mental health needs, you may be eligible for home care support.

Home care staff can help support you with daily activities such as getting in and out of bed, getting dressed and going to the toilet. On top of this, they may also help with daily living or domestic tasks like laundry, shopping and some meal preparation. The aim of support in your own home is to increase or maintain your independence so that you can remain living at home for as long as possible. The amount of support you require may reduce over time as you regain your ability to do things for yourself; we will work with you to review the level of support you need to stay independent in your own home.

If you have been ill or have just come out of hospital, you may benefit from short-term home care support (see page 8).

Home care services can be provided by:

- independent agencies;
- voluntary agencies; or
- individuals.

Home care can be paid for using a direct payment if you have one (see page 14 for more information).

If you have been assessed as being eligible for support, we will work with you to look at the best options to meet your care and support needs. If you need a personal budget to pay for your care, this will be based on your support plan. The amount of care you receive weekly will depend on your needs (worked out with us, as described on page 13). Carers must be specially trained in areas such as manual handling, first aid and food hygiene. They will also need to have had background checks with the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS), previously known as Criminal Records Bureau checks.

Some agencies offer a night sitting or even a livein service and some are also registered as nurses agencies, meaning they can provide registered nurses if needed. All home care organisations that provide personal care must register with, and be inspected by, the Care Quality Commission (CQC), which ensures that quality standards are met by the service and that staff are appropriately trained to do their job.



Looking after someone

If you provide unpaid support to help an adult live at home, you are a carer. Carers may be caring for an older person, someone who has a long-term physical illness or disability, a learning disability, mental health issue or substance misuse problem.

Caring may mean helping with practical tasks such as washing, dressing, taking medicines, shopping or laundry, providing emotional support, keeping an eye on someone to make sure that they are safe or looking after someone when they go out. Caring may have an effect on them, for example their



health, work, social life, finance, education, family and personal life. It is important that carers know what help is available to help the carer balance their caring life with a life of their own.

Carers hub

We pay Carers Trust East Midlands to run the Nottinghamshire Carers Hub to provide support to carers. This includes free advice, information and support to all carers. Carers Trust may be able to help in a number of ways, for example telephone or face-to-face advice, information about local support

Carer's assessment

Carers who regularly care for someone are entitled to a carer's assessment to look at the impact that caring has on the carer and to make sure that their own needs are addressed. For information regarding assessments, phone us on: **0300 500 80 80**.

If a carer needs some help for the person that they care for, and/or they want a regular break from caring, the person that is being cared for may need an assessment.

Carer's personal budget

If a carer is eligible for extra help, this will be

Carer's breaks

Carers sometimes need a break and this may be provided in several ways:

- the cared-for person may wish to go into a care home for a stay;
- a carer can move into the home to provide homebased respite care; or
- family-based respite care can be provided, where the cared-for person moves into another family's home for a short time.

The best option will depend on the carer's needs, the urgency of the situation and personal choice and cost.

The person being cared for will need to have an assessment to see if they are eligible for this service and they are likely to have to pay towards the cost of the short break.

Carer's emergency card

The carers' emergency card is a free small card that identifies carers in an emergency situation. It will alert anyone finding the card to the fact that the person is a carer and that someone they care for may require assistance. Once issued with a card, in the event of an emergency, the carer will have peace of mind that there is a 24-hour system in place to ensure that the person being cared for is looked after by the people that the carer has chosen. To apply for an emergency card, please phone: **0300 500 80 80**.

Crisis prevention support

We fund a scheme enabling the person being cared for to be looked after on a short-term basis in their home should their carer have an unforeseen or emergency situation. Examples of when the service can be used are when the carer:

- is too ill to provide care for a short period of time;
- needs to attend the funeral of a family member/ friend; or
- has a hospital appointment or is due to be admitted to hospital themselves.

Somewhere to live

While we will always work with you to help you stay in your own home for as long as it is safe to do so, sometimes this is not possible and you may need

to consider other living arrangements. Some other options available to you are listed in this section.

Shared Lives

Shared Lives aims to help people experience ordinary life with real relationships. It is a scheme where carers are trained to look after older people, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities or mental health needs. The support is mainly provided in the carer's home.

It is a regulated service for people who:

- need support to live in the community;
- are over 18; and
- are eligible for social care services.

Shared Lives can be delivered in several different ways:

- sharing or living in a carer's home and getting support with everyday life. This can be for a short period of time or it may be for months or years;
- daytime support where you have regular support sessions in the carer's home and out in the community; and
- outreach support where you live in your own home and the carer provides help where needed so you can live independently.

If you are eligible and Shared Lives is suitable for

your needs, we will try to match you with a carer. This means you get a chance to find out about the carer and they can find out about you to make sure everyone is happy before any support starts.

If you are eligible for Shared Lives, you may have a personal budget to pay for support. You will have to pay towards your living costs if you live with a carer or stay with them in their home.

Extra care housing

Extra care housing is high-quality accommodation where you can live as independently as possible, with the reassurance that care staff are on-site 24-hours a day, seven days a week.

Extra care housing is an extension to traditional supported housing and each extra care scheme is different. However, each provides you with your own front door, as well as offering a range of flexible services and facilities on-site that you could use, including communal areas.

Extra care housing offers:

Privacy, independence and security – you have the freedom to live your life how you wish, in your own home with your own front door; you can come and go as you please.

Control and choice – you keep complete control over your finances. Dependent on the accommodation on offer within each scheme, you can rent, buy or part own your home.

Support and flexibility – support is on hand to help you with everyday care and support tasks. The support provided is tailored to your own situation and changes according to your needs.

Stability – if your needs become greater, you don't have to move to get more support as the care offered by the on-site care team can change according to your needs.

Sense of community – communal areas allow you to easily socialise with other residents and join in group activities.

There are now 11 extra care schemes in Nottinghamshire:

- Westmorland House in Harworth
- Abbey Grove in Worksop
- Vale View in Newark
- Moorfield Court in Southwell
- Hilton Grange in Edwalton
- Cricketers Court in West Bridgford

- Spring Meadows in Cotgrave
- St Andrews in Mapperley
- Bilsthorpe Extra Care Scheme in Bilsthorpe
- Poppy Fields in Mansfield
- Darlison Court in Hucknall

In addition to the existing schemes, as part of our commitment to improving choice and support for older adults, we continue to develop further extra care schemes to increase the number of available places across the county.

Within each designated extra care housing scheme, we have nomination rights to a number of units of accommodation to be used as an alternative to residential care.

To be considered for one of our extra care housing schemes, you will need to be assessed by the Council as being eligible for social care support and requiring extra care accommodation. Residents will usually be aged 65 years and over, although in some circumstances, we may consider younger people for extra care housing.

Residential care

Before you think about residential care, please take time to look at the other options that are available to help you stay living independently at home. You may find that equipment, an adaptation to your home or support with washing and dressing means that you can stay in your own home for longer.

First, visit: **www.nottshelpyourself.org.uk** or phone: **0300 500 80 80** for details about a range of services which can help you.

There are also other options for somewhere to live when you can no longer stay at home, such as shared lives or extra care (see page 35).

If you are considering moving into residential care, you will need to have an assessment which will determine the level of your needs and whether you are eligible for social care support. This is strongly advised, even if you are funding the cost of your own care. Firstly, it will ensure that you have taken advantage of our expertise – we will be able to provide information and advice and possibly suggest alternative ways to meet your needs (which have been outlined in the sections above). Secondly, if you are moving into a care home and funding your own care, and your assets fall below the self-funder threshold of £23,250, you need to be aware that the Council will not automatically fund the full cost of the care home you are living in. In this situation, we will undertake a Care and Support Assessment and may not fund your care if you do not have assessed eligible needs. Or, if you have assessed eligible needs, we may only be able to contribute less than the cost of the care home you have chosen.

Types of homes

There are two types of care home:

Care homes (personal care only)

If you can no longer live independently and safely at home and need greater security and care, subject to an assessment, a care home offering personal care only may be the best option. Personal care includes bathing, feeding, dressing and help with moving but it must be paid for if your capital/savings exceed £23,250. See page 47 for more information on paying for your care.

Care homes with nursing

Care homes with nursing provide the same personal care support as a care home, but with fully-trained nursing staff available 24-hours a day. If you think

you may need nursing care in a home, you will need to be visited by a member of our social care team to work out what care you will need. This visit might be in your own home, or in hospital if you've been ill, or in a care home. You will be fully involved in planning your care needs.

If a care home providing nursing care is the best solution for you, we will give you information to help you find a home which meets your care requirements. The nursing care part of your fees is paid by the NHS to the home directly; the current amount is £112.00 per week for the lower rate and £154.14 per week for the higher rate. See page 51 for more information. Check with us for up-to-date figures.

Quality in care homes

Our staff visit each care home for older people every year and assess a range of factors; including how effectively managed the service is; how people are protected, if they are supported by competent staff; what their experience is like and whether care is focused around the person's needs and wishes.

Judgements on each standard are made following collection of evidence and are used to give each home a quality rating, with band one being the lowest quality and band five the highest. For further information on quality banded fee rates, see page 50.

The Care Quality Commission also inspects and reports on standards in care homes, see page 55 for more information.

What happens if my relative lives outside Nottinghamshire?

If you are considering choosing a home outside Nottinghamshire because it is nearer to your family or friends, then you may still be eligible for a financial contribution towards your placement. We will be able to give you more information about this during an assessment.

What happens when a council has suspended its agreement with a care home/care home with nursing?

While all care homes/care homes with nursing are required to be registered with the Care Quality Commission (see page 55), if we are contributing to your care fees, then we will have a separate agreement in place with the care home/care home with nursing. This is to ensure that the Council and the management staff at the care home/care home



with nursing know exactly what is required from the service. Occasionally it may be necessary to temporarily suspend placements into a care home/ care home with nursing. This may be done for a variety of reasons:

- to look into information of concern;
- to allow time for improvements to be made; or
- to take the pressure off a care home/care home with nursing if it is experiencing a problem.

Sometimes a care home/care home with nursing may voluntarily cease admitting people so that staff can make necessary improvements.

While a placement suspension is in place, no further Council-funded placements will be made to the care home/care home with nursing and further alternative placements should be sought.

If there are serious concerns about a care home/ care home regarding nursing, residents and/or their relatives/carers will be informed of the situation.

Specialist dementia care

Usually, the initial point of contact to access care services is your GP for health care solutions. For most other services you can contact us (for most other services) on: **0300 500 80 80**. Your GP, as well as discussing your concerns, will be able to refer you to the Memory Assessment Service in your area. This service will be able to carry out a series of tests which will establish the nature of your condition and advise whether treatment is possible. You will also be able to access the Dementia Advice and Support Service which can give advice about dementia and local support services.

If the time comes when remaining at home is no longer possible, the benefits of moving into a care home may need to be considered. Differentiating one care home from another can be difficult but the quality and quantity of staff training is especially important, along with the turnover of staff, as continuity of relationships in this type of home is critical. Advice on choosing care homes for people with dementia is available from the Alzheimer's Society: **www.alzheimers.org.uk** or Age UK: **www.ageuk.org.uk** and a checklist is included on page 45 to help when making your decision. We have also introduced the Dementia Quality Mark to recognise high-quality dementia care in care homes.



Dementia Quality Mark

The Dementia Quality Mark (DQM) was introduced to set the standard for high-quality dementia care in older people's care homes within Nottinghamshire. It is awarded to care homes that have evidenced that they provide a high standard of care to people living with dementia.

Criteria that the homes have to meet to achieve the award include: having a positive attitude towards dementia; allowing people with dementia emotional and physical freedom; ensuring daily routines are carried out, and providing meaningful activities and stimulation.

Care homes that are awarded the DQM receive an enhanced payment for residents living with dementia identified as requiring more specialist care.

End of life care

Although the subject of dying is often painful to contemplate, it is essential that you and your relatives discuss your wishes as you near the end of your life. Good planning for all your needs should mean that if you choose to, you can remain in your home or care home in your last days and not have to be admitted to hospital.

When choosing a service, you should consider its end of life care philosophy and policies. Enabling people to die in comfort and with dignity is a core part of providing care, and the way care professionals approach the process will be incredibly important for you, your family and carers.

The service should have an open approach to end of life care. It should initiate conversation with you and your family and work with your GP to ensure your needs and wishes are discussed and planned for. An end of life care plan should also be drawn up, as it is vital to establish your preferences and choices.

You could use the Preferred Priorities for Care (PPC) document to help with outlining your wishes. The PPC document is designed to help you prepare for the future and gives you an opportunity to think about, talk about and write down your preferences and priorities for care at the end of life. Search for 'PPC document' online to find a copy that you can fill in.

It is also important to know that all health and social care staff must be trained in communication regarding end of life care and will be trained in assessing the needs of individuals and carers.

It is worth asking care providers whether they are working towards The Gold Standards Framework. This can be used in various settings, for example hospitals, primary care and care homes, to improve the co-ordination and communication between different organisations involved in providing care for someone near the end of their life.

Residents

The best indication of a good home is that the residents appear happy and responsive.

- Are there rummage boxes around the home to stimulate residents?
- Is there good interaction between residents and staff?

Access

If the person with dementia needs or is likely to need equipment or adaptations you may want to check:

- There is adequate signage and cues for different parts of the home such as dining room and bathroom.
- The home's policy about locking external doors.
- Is there a safe garden area available?

Manager/head of home

A manager who is caring as well as efficient can make all the difference to a home.

- Does the manager have a knowledge of dementia and can they deal with difficulties that may arise in an understanding way?
- Is there a full assessment at home before a resident is admitted?

Staff

It is important to note whether staff seem friendly and caring towards residents and whether they treat residents with respect.

- Do they have any training and experience in dementia care?
- Will the person with dementia have a member of staff particularly responsible for their care?
- Is there a member of staff you can talk to about your own worries about the person with dementia?
- Do staff follow an individual and person-centred approach to providing care?

Bedrooms

You may want to find out whether the person with dementia can have a single room and whether:

• Residents are encouraged to bring in some of their own furniture and possessions to increase familiarity.

Activities

Residents should be stimulated without feeling stressed.

- Are reminiscence activities available?
- Are residents able to compile memory boxes?
- Do staff compile life story books including photographs and mementoes?

Toilets

Check whether:

- There are enough toilets within easy reach
- Staff are trained to spot the signs when someone needs to go to the toilet
- Staff are cheerful and tactful about helping residents use the toilet and changing them if they are incontinent

Meals

Meal times can play an important part of the day.

- Do meal times appear to be a relaxed and enjoyable experience?
- Do staff approach support at meal times in a flexible manner?
- Is there a variety of food available throughout the day (eg finger food)?

Health

- Which doctor or doctors can residents see?
- Can a relative stay overnight if a resident is unwell?
- What happens if residents need help with taking medication?

Financial arrangements for care

Do I need to pay for my own care?

If you are moving into residential care and your capital, which includes your savings and your other assets, is more than £23,250, you will be expected to pay for the full cost of your care and support.

The value of your home will be included in the calculations unless your partner, a relative who is over 60 or incapacitated, or a child under 16 who you or a former partner have legal responsibility for, still lives there.

If you are receiving care in your home, the value of that home is not taken into account when assessing your capital, but you are still required to pay the full cost of your care if your capital (not including your home) is more than £23,250.

If your capital is less than £14,250, the amount you need to contribute towards your care and support costs will be assessed on your income only. If it falls between £14,250 and £23,250 a sliding scale operates, whereby you contribute £1 per week for each £250 you have above the lower figure, plus a contribution from your income.

If your capital is less than £23,250, or is likely to fall below that level in the near future, please contact us on: **0300 500 80 80** before you arrange your care and support. We will be able to assess your needs for care and discuss with you what help is available to arrange the necessary financial support. If you move into a care home with nursing, the nursing part of your care will be free of charge. Your nursing care requirements will be determined by a nurse, who will visit you to carry out an assessment before you go into the home to ensure that this is the best place for you.

Seeking financial advice on paying for care

If you are paying for your own care, then meeting the care costs from limited capital whilst not knowing how long care might be needed, can be worrying. Despite this, many people do not seek appropriate financial advice to understand how best to meet the costs; as interest rates remain low it would be prudent to seek advice from a specialist financial adviser.

Money held on deposit can be depleted very quickly if being used to pay for care; therefore, it would be sensible to consider other forms of investments that could potentially deliver higher income to meet the care home fees.

Before deciding on what may be the most appropriate solution for meeting care costs, it would be sensible to talk to a specialist care fees adviser who has 'CF8', the relevant qualification for advising on funding long-term care.

Age UK's financial advice service offers a free and independent advice for people who are planning their future care costs.

You can speak to an independent financial adviser who is accredited by the **Society of Later Life Advisers (SOLLA)**. Older people's care home fee rates are based on a five band quality rating scale. Our staff currently visit each care home every year and assess a range of factors to determine how outcomes for residents are being met. This process is used to determine a quality rating. Band 5 is the highest rating that can be achieved, but it should be noted that, due to the Council regularly reviewing the care homes, the ratings can change.

Please note – the nursing rates above do not include the £112.00 nursing care contribution.

The above fees are those that we will pay as a contribution to the care home if we are funding your

care. However, please note that some care homes may charge more and the difference will need to be paid via a top-up or third party payment, discussed above.

Third party payments

The amount that we will pay to a care home or care home with nursing is determined by your needs and an annual quality assessment of every home in the county. This assessment takes into account the quality of care as well as environmental factors and enables every home to be given a Quality Band Rating (see below).

In some cases, the home you choose will cost more than the Quality Band Rate. If this is the case, you

will need to ask someone, perhaps a family member, a friend or a charity, to make up the difference so you can live in the home. This is known as a 'third party payment' or 'top-up'.

With third party payments, it's important that the person making the payments is confident they'll be able to keep up their commitment. They also need to be aware that the third party payment may change at any point in the future.

NHS continuing healthcare

NHS continuing healthcare is a package of care arranged and funded by the NHS. It is not meanstested and, to be eligible, your main or primary need must relate to your health and meet the criteria set out by the NHS National Framework.

Care may be provided in a variety of settings including a care home or your own home. If care is provided in a care home, NHS continuing healthcare will cover the care home fees, including the cost of accommodation, personal care and healthcare costs. If it is provided in the home, it will cover personal care and healthcare costs.



NHS funded nursing care

If you live in a care home that provides nursing care, whether as a temporary or a permanent resident, and you do not meet the eligibility criteria for NHS continuing healthcare, you may be eligible for NHS funded nursing care if you need care from a registered nurse.

This is not means-tested and can be paid directly to the home by the Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) or paid by us on behalf of the CCG. The current rates are £112.00 a week for the standard rate and £154.14 a week for the higher rate. Contact us for up-to-date figures.

People who receive nursing care will still need to make a financial contribution towards their residential care.

Paying for your own care in a nursing or residential home

Even if you are paying for your own care (if you have assets of over £23,250), we would still advise you to contact us for a Care and Support Assessment. This means that we can make you aware of all the options available. If you do not have an assessment and your assets are, or fall below £23,250, the Council may not be able to support you until after you have had an assessment and we can determine that you are receiving the appropriate level of care for your needs.

Depending on the type of care and support that you are eligible for, you may be entitled to the following financial support.



Benefits and Pension Credit

If you're aged 65 or over and you need someone to help care for you, you may be eligible for Attendance Allowance (AA), Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payment (PIP), non-meanstested, non-taxable benefits from the Department for Work and Pensions.

Twelve-week property disregard

If your former home is included in your financial assessment but your other capital is less than £23,250 and your income doesn't cover your care home fees, we may help with the cost during the first twelve weeks of permanent care, providing we agree that this type of care is needed.

This is known as 'twelve-week property disregard funding'. During this time, you will still be charged a contribution towards the cost of your care, but not the full cost.

Deferred payment agreements

Once the twelve-week property disregard period has ended, you may be able to have a deferred payment agreement if you are eligible, which means that some of your care costs are set against the value of your home, to be paid when the home is sold. There may be administrative and interest charges for this.

We strongly recommend seeking independent financial advice if you are considering this option.

Council Tax exemption

If your property is left empty when you move into a care home, you should receive full exemption from Council Tax until such time as your property is sold.

Safeguarding adults at risk of abuse and/or neglect

An adult at risk is a person aged 18 years or over who can't protect themselves from abuse or from being exploited.

This may be because they have:

- a mental health condition or learning disability;
- a physical impairment;
- a sensory impairment; or
- some form of illness or are old and frail.

What is safeguarding?

Safeguarding means protecting an adult's right to live in safety, free from abuse and neglect. It is about people and organisations working together to prevent and stop both the risks and experience of abuse or neglect, whilst making sure that the adult's wellbeing is promoted, including consideration of their views, wishes, feelings and beliefs in deciding on any action. The aim of adult safeguarding is to:

- stop abuse or neglect wherever possible;
- prevent harm and reduce the risk of abuse or neglect to adults with care and support needs;
- safeguard adults in a way that supports them in making choices and having control about how they want to live, focusing on outcomes that are important to them;
- promote an approach that concentrates on improving life for the adults concerned;
- raise public awareness so that communities as a whole, alongside professionals, play their part in preventing, identifying and responding to abuse and neglect; and
- provide information and support in accessible
 ways to help people understand the different
 types of abuse, how to stay safe and what to do

Safeguarding adults at risk of abuse and/or neglect continued

to raise a concern about the safety or wellbeing of an adult; and address what has caused the abuse or neglect.

Forms of abuse could be physical, sexual, psychological, discriminatory or financial. It could also be forms of neglect including self-neglect or organisational abuse, where the abuse is a result of the way a service or organisation is run. Abuse might also be linked to modern slavery or as a result of domestic abuse.

It can happen anywhere – in someone's own home, in a care home, a hospital, in a workplace, at a day centre or educational establishment, in supported housing or in the street.

What to do if you think someone is at risk

We are committed to ensuring that adults who use

services are protected from abuse and neglect and to responding promptly when abuse is suspected. All agencies that provide services to adults have a zero tolerance approach towards abuse and neglect.

Contact us on: **0300 500 80 80** to report a safeguarding incident or for further help and advice. Your concerns will be taken seriously and will receive prompt attention.

If there is danger to life, a risk of injury, or a crime is taking place and immediate action is needed, call the Police using: **999**.

Support for younger adults

There is a wide range of support available from the community for people with physical disabilities, long-term illness, learning disabilities, Asperger's, mental health difficulties and/or sensory impairment. **www.nottshelpyourself.org.uk** is a good source of information about available support and services in the community.

We provide a range of support for people with a disability or mental health difficulty who are eligible for social care support. For many services you will need a Care and Support Assessment (discussed on page 13) to determine if you are eligible.

Services include: support to live at home; equipment and adaptations; assistive technology; occupational therapy; Shared Lives and short-term support to promote independence.

Housing options for younger adults

We aim to help people maintain their independence. If you are eligible for social care services, we can help you to consider which housing and support option might best meet your needs.

You may wish to continue living in your own home and we may be able to help you do this. We could arrange for someone to visit you and help you develop or maintain your independent living skills, or we could assess your home for possible adaptations.

If your assessment indicates that you need a more supported environment, one of our supported living schemes may meet your needs. This is available to people with a range of needs and offers a level of independence and the chance to meet other people in similar situations. People with high levels of needs can live in supported living with appropriate support in place. Staff will be available at agreed times and will work with you to help you do the things that are important to you.

People living in supported living usually have their

own tenancy and have access to a whole range of welfare benefits. There are schemes in every district of the county. These will be either a block of flats or a shared house.

If you are unable to remain at home or move into supported living, then in exceptional cases you

Mental health

If you are experiencing mental health difficulties, it is important that you seek help from your GP. Where appropriate, your GP will be able to refer you to a number of different health services to meet your needs, including referrals to psychological therapies and specialist psychiatric assessments.

In each locality there are social care teams that work closely with health professionals to support people experiencing mental health difficulties. The social may need to consider residential care on either a short-term or long-term basis. We will contribute if you are eligible and agree that a care home best meets your needs. If your chosen home costs more than local authority limits, you may get some help but you must pay the rest. Paying for care is discussed on page 47.

care staff can offer a reablement service (short-term support to promote independence) as well as a Care and Support Assessment that may lead to the provision of a personal budget. Where a person is eligible for a personal budget, they will be supported in using this to access a range of services to support them to live independently. These services will be reviewed regularly to ensure they continue to support independence.

Comments, compliments and complaints

All organisations need to know how they are performing. They are happy to receive your feedback on their service whether they are compliments or complaints. Feel free to tell them what you think – your comments can be used constructively to improve the service.

If you do need to make a complaint, you should feel able to complain about any aspect of your care that affects your happiness or comfort. This could be about the way you are treated by a staff member or the quality of the food. You can also make comments and suggestions about possible improvements to your surroundings and the services provided.

Making a complaint should not be made difficult for you. Providers are required under the essential standards of quality and safety to have a simple and easy to use complaints procedure that they will be happy to give you. If you are concerned about the care that you, a friend or a relative is receiving, it makes sense to speak to the manager before you take any further action. The problem may be resolved quite easily once they are made aware of it. However, if you need to make a formal complaint, you should initially contact the registered owners of the service. They have a duty to respond to any complaints made.

Inspecting and regulating care services

All care providers must be registered under a system which brings adult social care, independent healthcare and the NHS under a single set of essential standards of quality and safety.

The Care Quality Commission (CQC) registers, inspects and reviews all adult social care and healthcare services in England in the public, private and voluntary sectors. This includes care homes, care homes with nursing, home care agencies and NHS services, amongst others.

Inspectors carry out a mixture of announced and unannounced inspections looking at the quality and safety of the care provided. They look at whether the service is, Safe, Effective, Caring, Responsive to people's needs, and Well-led.

Inspection teams are led by an experienced CQC manager and often include experts in their field. The team may also include professional or clinical staff; Experts by Experience; people who use services; and carers.

Following an inspection, each care home and home care agency is given a report of how it rates against national essential standards of quality and safety. The CQC has also started rating services as: Outstanding; Good, Requires Improvement and Inadequate. When considering a care service, it's always a good idea to check its inspection report and rating on the CQC's comprehensive website: **www.cqc.org.uk** or ask the care provider you are considering for a copy of their latest inspection report.




