Benefits of the Support with Confidence scheme

If you employ a Personal Assistant (PA), you can access training and accreditation for them through the Support with Confidence scheme. The Support with Confidence scheme is an accreditation process for PAs that is free and open to all existing and prospective PAs within Nottinghamshire. Support with Confidence offers a free DBS check, access to training and an online forum. Accredited PAs may also find additional work if they wish by being listed on www.nottshelpyourself.org.uk

Optimum Workforce Leadership:

Skills for Care is an organisation that offers information and funding opportunities to the health and social care sector.

Apply for funding from Skills for Care, through the skills for workforce development fund, to train your PA or develop their skills further. This funding can be applied for even if PAs are not on the Support with Confidence scheme.

This funding can only be applied for by the employer on behalf of the PA.
