Mick, Sonya,

Following a wall collapse incident on a schools project in Scotland, Transform Schools Bassetlaw undertook a visual inspection of all schools and a technical review of the As Built Structural Drawings. This work identified minor issues at 2 schools relating to the construction of a Bin Store and a Sprinkler Tank Housing, in both cases the matters related to walls being built higher than the wind posts and the incorrect hanging of metal gates, both of these matters have now been rectified.

At the time of the inspections and reviews no issues were identified with the main school buildings, the Annual Condition Surveys will include a visual inspection of main structural walls. Should the surveys identify any suspected areas then Transform Schools will notify the Council and deal with the issue.
