

Freedom of information request NCC-027190-17

Thank you for your recently submitted freedom of information request for the following information:

Under the FOI Act I would like to request information about pay for care workers that work sleeping night shifts.

How much did you pay your care workers for doing a sleeping night shift prior to the national minimum wage law changing in April 2015?

Do you now pay the national minimum wage? (£7.50 p/h for ever 25s)

If yes, was the uplift immediately after the law was changed?

If not, how was back pay calculated for your employees?

Our response

Nottinghamshire County Council can confirm the rate for sleeping in allowance night shift is £34.68 per night.

Staff pay is calculated so that they do not receive less than £7.50ph for staff over 25 and £7.05ph for staff 21-24.
