I refer to your letter dated 3 October 1996 concerning the above, and enclosed copy of a plan that might shed some light on the situation. The plan dated 1921 shows a different boundary for field number 12 than the one that is present today. In 1953, which was the year in which the paths were recorded in Warsop, this was the line which the Urban District Council claimed and was eventually put on the Definitive Map.

Therefore, since this path is recorded on the definitive map then that is where the route is officially recognised, regardless of where the route is being walked. This is the route that must be marked on the plan for the Section 31(6) and statement. The deposit would prevent the section that is currently being walked from becoming recognised as a Right of Way by presumed dedication by being used for 20 years or more.




